ORDER ON PRELIMINARY INJUNCTIVE RELIEF PURSUANT TO ARKANSAS RULE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE 65

On September 18, 2024 the Court held hearing on Plaintiff's Petition for a preliminary injunction under Arkansas Rule of Civil Procedure 65. After considering the pleadings, exhibits filed in support of the preliminary injunction, and arguments of counsel the Court hereby finds:

- 1. Plaintiff has met her burden under Arkansas Rule of Civil Procedure 65 that she has a reasonable likelihood to prevail on the merits of her action.
- 2. Plaintiff will suffer irreparable harm and lacks an otherwise adequate remedy if a preliminary injunction is not entered.
- 3. Defendants voiced no objection to the entry of a preliminary injunction for a reasonable time until a final hearing on the merits can be scheduled or until further order of the Court.

For these reasons, the Court finds that a preliminary injunction is appropriate under Arkansas Rule of Civil Procedure 65. Defendants, Defendants' officers, agents, servants, employees and attorneys, and other persons who are in active concert or participation with Defendants are hereby enjoined from producing any documents in response to the August 23, 2024 Freedom of Act Request from Mark Friedman. This preliminary injunction will remain in place

up through the time that a final hearing is completed and the Court can rule on the merits of this action or until further order of the Court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Plaintiff Courtney Rae Hudson's request for a preliminary injunction under Arkansas rule of Civil Procedure 65 is granted.
