Honorable Justices:

Please accept this letter in lieu of a more formal brief in opposition to the State's petition for certification in the above-referenced matter. In support of his opposition to the State's petition, defendant-respondent Edwin Andujar relies on the Appellate Division's cogent decision, as well as the appellate brief filed on his behalf.

The Appellate Division's decision in this matter properly recognized that the trial judge had no more cause after the record check than he had before the record check to exclude F.G. from the jury. While the State's decision to arrest F.G. outside the courtroom made him unavailable, he was eligible for jury duty. As the Appellate Division noted, the judge's credibility determination was "well within the considerable discretion afforded the court in such matters." State v. Andujar, 2020 N.J. Super. LEXIS 23 (February 24, 2020), at *33. The State presents no substantial issue for certification, and its petition should be denied.
